	 Each drug store will be considered a separate independent entity. Drug store(s) will be allotted to the highest successful bidder. The validity of the contract under tender will be a maximum up to Three Years. The minimum reserve price for the license fee shall be Rs. 75,000/- per month. The contract will be renewed every eleven months with minimum 10% annual increase in previous year's license fee. For renewal of contract, licensee should submit application 2 months before the completion of contract period. The payment of the applicable taxes time to time is sole responsibility of the licensee. License fee can be increased over and above the 10% increase and re-fixed at the time of next extension/ renewal of agreement, which will be effective from the date of renewal of agreement. Extensions in allotment will be at the sole discretion of Vice-chancellor. The drug stores will remain open around the clock (24 hours) 7 days a week, failing which action will be taken. Licensee should have a valid license from the competent authority for the sale of drugs. 				

- 11. Allottee should also have license for sale of blood collection bags and scheduled drugs like anesthetics/ opioids etc. and shall have to maintain record of the sale of such drugs as per govt. norms. The allottee shall be responsible for compliance of norms /regulations of the Government notified from time to time and the University shall not be liable for any noncompliance by the allottee.
- 12. The License will have to get his own electricity connection from the PSPCL in his own name and bear the costs for it.
- 13. The Licensee will give **minimum of 10% discount** on MRP of drugs/items. The discount should be displayed clearly visible place both in English & Punjabi.
