

Check-List of Documents to be Submitted at Counselling:

- (i) Self-attested copies of educational qualification certificates and mark sheets from 10th class onwards issued by the Board/University, Proof of Date of Birth (Birth certificate, 10th class certificate), Character Certificate and transcript/detail marks of qualifying examination.
- (ii) Self-attested copy of Rank/Score achieved in NEETUG-2026 for B.V.Sc.&A.H and MET-Vet 2026-27/ GAT-B-2026 for Master Programmes (as applicable).
- (iii) Original certificate issued by the competent authority in support of the claim of belonging to SC/ST or BC or to any other reserved category(ies), in which admission is sought in the prescribed format (Annexure I-VI, IX A, B, C).
- (iv) Self-declaration (Annexure VII) and a self-attested copy of the Residence Certificate obtained from the competent authority in the prescribed format (Annexure VII A) as per instructions/guidelines of Punjab Government (Annexure-E).
- (v) Income certificate for candidates under SC/ST category with annual family income below Rs. 2.5 lakhs for claiming Post-Matric Scholarship and/or fee concession (Annexure I, Form-B).
- (vi) Income and assets certificate for candidates under EWS category (Annexure XIII)
- (vii) Income certificate for candidates under BC category (Annexure II, Form-B).
- (viii) Self-undertaking of gap in study period, if applicable (Annexure X-A).
- (ix) Self undertaking as per Annexure X-B for the information of Board (10+2) class.
- (ix) Certificate for In-service Candidates (Annexure VIII).
- (x) Undertaking regarding Anti-Ragging (Annexure XI-A, B).
- (xi) Latest Copy of Aadhar Card of Candidate and his/ her mother.
- (xii) Self-attested copy of Election Photo Identity Card (EPIC). The candidates who do not have an EPIC card must apply for the same at the website of Election Commission of India as per FORM-6 (Annexure XII).
