INTRODUCTION

Guru Angad Dev Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Ludhiana was established on 21st April, 2006 through Punjab Act no. 16 of 2005. The primary focus of the university is to serve the society by promoting livestock production and health through integrated teaching, research, and extension. The University has been recognized and accredited by UGC and ICAR with Grade "A".

The university has attributed two constituent institutes (college & polytechnic) and one private affiliated college to impart Diploma in Veterinary Science and Animal Health Technology (Dip.V.Sc & A.H.Tech.)

(a) Constituent Institutes:

(i) Veterinary Polytechnic, Kaljharani: Veterinary Polytechnic, Kaljharani, District Bathinda was established in the year 2010 as a constituent college of Guru Angad Dev Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Ludhiana to impart education of Diploma in Veterinary Science and Animal Health Technology to support the veterinary services through trained para-veterinary staff. The institute has its own well-developed Sahiwal cattle farm of 250 cows and a Beetal Goat farm of 50 goats with a view to impart practical training to the students. The institute also has a well-furnished hostel with all the latest facilities like gym, playground, rooms etc. The Diploma in Veterinary Science and Animal Health Technology has been designed to train human resource in developing para-veterinary personnels. The trainees after completing the Diploma course shall be able to co-ordinate and work under the supervision of Registered Veterinary Practitioners to provide better health care to domesticated animals in Veterinary Hospitals, Veterinary Colleges, Research and Training Institutes, Cooperative Sector and Non- Government Organizations etc. Majority of the students after successful completion of their studies have been appointed in the Department of Animal Husbandry, Cooperative Sector, GADVASU and some Non- Government organizations.

(ii) College of Veterinary Science, Rampura Phul, Bathinda: The College of Veterinary Science, Rampura Phul, Bathinda was established as a constituent college of Guru Angad Dev Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Ludhiana. The foundation stone of the college was laid on 30th October, 2014. It became functional on October 1, 2019 by admitting 80 students to the B.V.Sc & A.H. programme with the approval of Veterinary Council of India. The mandate of the college is to produce veterinary graduates, para-professionals and trained personnels to serve the animal husbandry sector in the state. In addition, its endeavor will be to implement the research outputs and extension education programmes for better livestock health and production, especially in the South- Western zone of Punjab. The college campus comprises of college buildings, veterinary hospital, farms, playgrounds and fodder production area. The residential complex comprises of hostels, guest house and staff quarters.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Academic Programme and Mode of selection for Admission

The University offers admission to Dip.V.Sc.&A.H.Tech programme. The mode of admission for the programme shall be as under:

Breaking of Tie in the Merit List: In case of tie in the merit list, the following criteria will be adopted for breaking the tie:-

- 1. The candidate obtaining higher marks in Biology in 10+2 examination, followed by
- 2. The candidate obtaining higher marks in Chemistry in 10+2 examination, followed by
- 3. Candidate older in age.

Note:-

- (i) Date of counselling will not ordinarily be changed even if declared holiday.
- (ii) Candidates absent in counselling will not be eligible for selection.
- (iii) At the time of counselling, the Selection Committee shall also consider the past record of the candidate as to his/her conduct as a student in the School/College or elsewhere. If it is known that the candidate being considered for admission has been involved in any act of indiscipline or unlawful activities in the hostel, in the school/college, or in organizing demonstration etc., the Selection Committee may refuse admission to such candidate and the decision of the Selection Committee shall be final.

Application procedure

The candidate applying for admission to diploma programme of the college will have to fill the *online application* form at the university website (www.gadvasu.in)

Last date to apply/ receipt of application form:

- o 28.07.2022 (without late fee)
- o 02.08.2022 with late fee of Rs. 1000/- (non-refundable)

Application fee:

Rs. 2,000/- to be paid in online mode only (non-refundable)

Eligibility Criteria for Admission to Diploma Programme

Minimum 50% marks (40% for SC/ST/BC and DP categories) in (10+2) examination passed with **Biology, Physics, Chemistry and English** subjects from a Board recognized by Council of Boards of School Education (COBSE) in India, excluding optional subjects.

- 1. Admission proforma for admission can be downloaded from the university website www.gadvasu.in at least one week before counselling. Duly filled form along with enclosures is to be submitted by the candidate at the time of counselling. Candidates are also required to produce original certificates/testimonials for verification at the time of counselling.
- 2. Applicants who have applied under **sports category** (**Annexure C of prospectus**) and **under Armed Force Category** (**Annexure IV-A & IV-B**) must submit supporting documents upto 04.08.2022 (4.00 p.m.) in the office of Director of Students' Welfare-cum-Estate Officer and Registrar, respectively failing which their claim for admission under these categories shall stand cancelled.
- 3. To avoid any kind of inconvenience or last-minute rush or unforeseen difficulties, the candidates are advised to submit application forms without waiting for the last dates.

Selection Procedure: Admissions will be made as per the merit list on the basis of marks obtained by the candidate in the Qualifying examination (aggregate of marks of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English in 10+2).

Note:

- 1. The Academic Council of the University is the academic authority to frame rules and regulations, and to decide all other matters relating to admissions and academic affairs. The Academic Council also has the right to promote or discontinue any programme and also to increase or decrease seats in any programme, whatsoever.
- 2. Diploma programme of the university is full time residential programme. A student, therefore, cannot study more than one programme at a time. The admission to the Diploma course shall be made by the Registrar, GADVASU (on the recommendation made by the Chairman of the selection committee) who reserves the right to cancel the admission before or during the diploma course obtained by misrepresentation/concealment of facts or admission made due to error or oversight etc.

COUNSELLING SCHEDULE

The University will prepare category wise merit list of applicants based on marks obtained by the candidate in the qualifying examination (10+2) aggregate of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English. The merit list of applicants will be displayed on university website (www.gadvasu.in) before the date of 1st counselling. The candidate wishing to seek admission in the university must attend the counselling as per schedule below:

NOTES:

- 1. Once the seat is allotted, no shifting among quotas/college will be allowed in 1st counselling.
- 2. Status of vacant seats, if any, will be available on the university website one day prior to 2nd counselling.
- 3. Date of special counselling, if any, will be notified on the university website. The candidates are required to check the university website regularly for updates in this regard.
- 4. The candidates appearing in the counselling are required to produce all the original certificates, otherwise the candidature will not be considered.
- 5. No separate intimation will be sent for counselling for consideration of admission, the candidate must be physically present at counselling as per schedule. Absentees, for any reason whatsoever, will not be considered for admission.
- 6. The University will not pay any T.A. / D.A. or any other expenses for appearing in the Counselling.
- 7. If a candidate misses the first counselling, he/she can attend the subsequent counselling (s), but the admission will be made strictly merit wise of the remaining available seats.
- 8. During counselling, the candidates will be called in the descending order of merit prepared by the University as per set criteria.
- 9. The fee for 1st semester may be deposited by bank draft in favour of Principal Veterinary Polytechnic, Kaljharani/Dean, College of Veterinary Science, Rampura Phul, as applicable payable at any scheduled bank at Ludhiana, by Debit/Credit card with limit equal to full fee or by cash, at the time of admission immediately after counselling by the selected candidates at GADVASU, Ludhiana. In case of failure to deposit full fee at the time of admission, seat will be offered to next eligible candidate as per the merit list according to the terms and conditions detailed in Chapter V.
- 10. All the selected candidates shall have to submit **Medical Fitness Certificate** obtained from University Medical Officer, on the day of registration in the office of the Principal of the College where the candidate is seeking admission. The Medical examination fee of Rs 430/will be charged by University Hospital. The candidate not found medically fit will be refunded the fee paid by him/her after following approved procedure and the seat will be offered to the next candidate at the next counselling.

- 11. Date of counselling will not change under ordinary conditions, even if, declared a holiday.
- 12. For the candidates seeking seats in self-financed category or management quota of private college, if they wish to change/withdraw their seat under any circumstances, the fees shall only be refunded if the seat is filled by the subsequent candidate, otherwise, the fees will not be refunded. The refund of fees will require certain processing time of the university (Refer to Chapter V-Refund Policy)
- 13. An "Admission proforma" for admission to diploma programme, will be available on the university website before counselling. The duly filled admission proforma along with self-attested copies of all the relevant documents (as per checklist) must be submitted by the candidate at the time of counselling. Simultaneously, the various original certificates/ documents listed in this chapter are required to be submitted/ shown to the Counselling Committee, failing which candidate will not be considered for admission.
- 14. The candidates selected for Diploma in Veterinary Science and Animal Health Technology shall be required to deposit fees on their selection immediately after counselling, failing which the seat will be offered to the next candidate on merit list. The selection letter will be issued to a candidate only when he/she has deposited the full fee. All the selected candidates shall have to submit medical fitness certificate to be obtained from University Medical Officer. Any candidate found medically unfit, shall be entitled to refund of fees. In such cases the application for refund must be submitted within 14 days from the date of issue of selection notice.
- 15. No admission shall be made after the last date of admission, unless date(s) for special counselling(s) are notified/declared by the University.

Candidates who are resident of Punjab State/ Union Territory of Chandigarh, seeking admission to diploma programme, required to furnish self-declaration (Annexure VII) and Residence Certificate (Annexure A) as applicable as per instructions/guidelines issued from Punjab Government regarding competent authority to issue Residence Certificate at the time of counselling.
- 2. Candidates applying for seats reserved for States other than Punjab and Union Territory of Chandigarh are required to furnish self-declaration (**Annexure VII**) and Residence Certificate issued from competent authority of respective state at the time of counselling.
- 3. Seats remaining vacant under "States other than Punjab" at Veterinary Polytechnic, Kaljharani will be filled from self-financed category and vice versa.
- 4. Candidates from other states fulfilling the eligibility criteria for admission at College of Veterinary Science, Rampura Phul will be considered against remaining seats for admission under Self finance^b category only after the candidates from Punjab and UT Chandigarh.

IMPORTANT

- 1. The University reserves the right to enhance the rates of fee/charges and funds etc. from time to time. An annual increase of 10% in the fee structure shall be applicable to the constituent colleges of the university.
- 2. The securities not claimed for two semesters succeeding the ending of semester in which the student leaves the college, shall lapse.
- 3. All claims for refund of hostel security shall be entertained through the Principal/Dean of the college.
- 4. The University is authorized to realize additional charges proportionally from the hostellers through the Principal/Dean of the college, the Generator running cost at hostel and also the electricity consumption bills, if in excess than the normal.
- 5. If any candidate wishes to shift his/her seat from one category/quota to another. He/she has to pay the entire fee again for another seat, no fee shall be adjusted. The previous paid fee shall undergo a proper refund process (if eligible) and then only the fee shall be refunded.
- 6. The private colleges/institutes affiliated to GADVASU will charge the same fees from the students eligible for Post Matric Scholarship Scheme admitted under SC/ST Category (University Quota) as is being charged by the university from the students of said category in respect of the particular course.
- 7. Hostel accommodation at Private affiliated college shall be provided subject to availability.

Fee Concession

Fee Concession

Provision of fee concession is available only for the students enrolled at Veterinary Polytechnic, Kaljharani. The Dean, College of Veterinary Science, Rampura Phul (Controlling Officer, Veterinary Polytechnic, Kaljharani) can remit tuition fee of upto 10% of students of Diploma in Veterinary Science and Animal Health Technology admitted during a given academic year on recommendation of the Principal-cum-Joint Director, Veterinary Polytechnic, Kaljharani.

Out of these 10% students,

- > 3% will be granted 100%,
- > next 3% will be granted 50%, and
- remaining 4% will be granted 33.3% concession in tuition fee.

The students with lowest family income will be given priority in higher slab of fee concession. However, the girl students will be given priority in full tuition fee concession to promote the education of a girl child from economically weaker sections.

The students enrolled through Self Finance Programme shall not be eligible for fee concession as per the University guidelines.

It is further clarified that there is no provision of fee concession at College of Veterinary Science, Rampura Phul under any category.

REGULATION REGARDING RUSTICATION AND EXPULSION OF STUDENTS

- 1. The Principal/Dean of the college shall have the power to expel or rusticate a student for sufficient reasons including acts of indiscipline and misconduct inside or outside the college.
- 2. Cases of rustication and expulsion shall be reported to the Registrar, GADVASU by the Principal/Dean of the College through the controlling officer immediately after rustication or expulsion for registration and notification.
- 3. The Principal/Dean may revise his decision within 15 days of the date of passing of the order of rustication or expulsion. The revised decision together with reasons shall be communicated to the Registrar for placing before the Academic Council.
- 4. The minimum period of rustication shall be one semester and the maximum period of rustication shall be two semesters.
- 5. The student under rustication shall have the option of re-joining the class during the ensuing semester after the expiry of the period of rustication.
- 6. It shall be obligatory on the part of the college to readmit a rusticated student if he/she wishes to re-join after the expiry of the rustication period.
- 7. The name of the rusticated student shall not be maintained on the rolls of the college nor shall any fees be charged during the period of rustication.
- 8. A student expelled from the college shall not be allowed to seek fresh admission into the same college or into another college without the permission of the Academic Council. In no case such a student shall be allowed to do so before the expiry of two academic years excluding the academic year in which he/she was expelled.
- 9. When facts come to the knowledge of the Vice-Chancellor, GADVASU which makes him think that the order of the Principal/Dean requires revision, the Vice-Chancellor may bring the case to notice of the Academic Council after consideration of which, the decision of the Academic Council shall be final.
- 10. Ragging is strictly prohibited. Any student found indulging in the act of ragging will be strictly dealt with according to the directions given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. According to Raghavan Committee observations, ragging has several aspects including psychological, social, political, economic, cultural and academic dimensions.
 - Anti-ragging committees and squads at the college/polytechnic have been constituted to keep a check on the incidents of ragging. Every student as well as his/her parents/guardian is supposed to submit an affidavit that he/she or their ward will desist from ragging in any form. If found guilty, it may invite punishment upto expulsion from the institute or registration of F.I.R. under provisions of the Indian Penal Code.
 - An annual undertaking to be signed by each student whether fresher or senior, and his/her parent(s) jointly stating that each of them have read the relevant instructions/regulations against ragging as well as punishments, and that if the ward has been found guilty, he/she should be proceeded against (Annexure X-A, B).
 - Undertaking should be provided in English as well as in the vernacular language (Annexure X-A,B).

SCHOLARSHIPS, STIPENDS, AWARDS, MERIT CERTIFICATES AND MEDALS

Merit Certificate

The University has instituted Merit Certificates for the students who achieve an OCPA of 8.000 (out of 10.000) or more at the end of their Diploma in Veterinary Science & Animal Health Technology.

Post Matric Scholarship (PMS) Scheme

It is a centrally sponsored scheme with a 60:40 sharing ratio between the Centre and States (90:10 in case of North Eastern States).

Eligibility

Scholarships will be paid to the scheduled caste students whose parents'/guardians' income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2,50,000/- (Rupees two lakh fifty thousand only) during the last financial year. Income certificate is required to be taken once only i.e. at the time of admission only to courses which are continuing for more than one year. The income certificate shall be issued by the Authority as decided by the State Government.

The scholarship includes: - Compulsory non-refundable fees including tuition fee, as fixed by the Fee Fixation/ Rationalization Committee of the State Government and Academic Allowance (10% extra allowance for Divyang (physically challenged) students.

Freeship Card

All eligible students shall be entitled to take admission in the institutions without prepayment of tuition fees and hostel fees (but will pay refundable charges) as per the Scheme Guidelines available on the site https://scholarships.gov.in under Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment. To enable this, a FREESHIP CARD will be issued by the State Government to the eligible students. This Freeship card shall make the student eligible to study in the institution without pre-payment of the fees, and on the condition that as and when amount is released to the student's account, the institution would be intimated to collect the same from the student.

Student should have a valid functional Mobile Number, Aadhar Number (UID), Aadhar linked Bank Account, Income Certificate, Caste Certificate and Passing Certificate for applying on the Dr Ambedkar Scholarship Portal, Government of Punjab at www.scholarships.punjab.gov.in (select 'New Registration' from 14-04-2022 onwards). The student shall, well before the expected date of admission, register for issuance of a Freeship Card on the respective scholarship portal giving the details like the Aadhaar number, the name of the course in which he/she wants to take admission (e.g. M.Sc./ M.V.Sc./ B.V.Sc./ B.Sc./ B.Tech./ Diploma etc.) and an undertaking that the institution's charges would be paid within 7 working days from the date of receipt of the scholarship amount in his/her account. For the purpose of registration of Freeship Card, the portals shall remain open throughout the year. For the purpose of admission, the Freeship card will remain valid for period of one year from the date of issue.

Note: Those without Freeship card will have to deposit the full fee.

- (viii) At the time of counselling, the candidate is required to present the hard copy of the submitted application form and the original certificates.
- (ix) The university possesses no boarding facilities for the candidates taking admission in Certificate/Short courses. So, they have to arrange accommodation at their own level.
- (x) The reservation policy will be followed as per guidelines of the state government and as mentioned in other programmes of the university.
- (xi) The in-service candidates deputed by the employer will be given preference in admission.

The matter has been reconsidered in the light of judgment delivered by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Dr. Pradeep Jain vs. Union of India and others reported as AIR 1984-SC- 1421 wherein it was held that instead of the word "Domicile" the word "Residence" be used in the instructions issued by the State Government on the subject. Accordingly, it has been decided by the Government to revise the Government instructions referred to above as under:

ANNEXURE – C CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION OF OUTSTANDING SPORTS PERSONS

- 1. The admission against the sports quota shall be finalized on the basis of recommendations of the Sports Committee constituted by the DSW-cum-Estate Officer and approved by the Director Extension Education and DSW-cum-Estate Officer.
- 2. The candidates applying for admission under sports quota shall have to obtain a gradation certificate from the Sports Department, Govt. of Punjab for their performance at 10+1 and 10+2 level. No weightage will be given to the candidates who have participated after 10+2 level.
- 3. The shortlisted candidates in order of merit, three times the number of available seats, will undergo trails for satisfactory performance. The tracks will be video-graphed, and obtaining a satisfactory grading will be mandatory for admission under sports quota.
- 4. In case of similar grades
 - a) The candidate having won first position shall be placed higher in merit than the candidate who has won second position in a competition of the same level. Similarly candidate having second position shall be placed at higher merit than the third position in a competition of same level, and so on.
 - b) The candidate who has got the position/represented twice will be preferred over candidates who have got the position/represented once in a competition of same level in a game.
 - c) In case of further tie, criteria mentioned under Chapter II will be applicable.
- 5. The candidate shall be required to submit self-declaration in the prescribed form as per **Annexure B** regarding his/her achievements in sports. If the candidate is a minor, declaration may be given by the parents/guardian in respect of his/her ward's/child's achievements in sports.
- 6. The admission of candidates against the sports quota shall be made on the explicit understanding that they shall attend the play fields regularly and shall also participate in various tournaments. If they fail to do so, their admission shall be cancelled.
