ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Abstract should be of original and quality research works/Clinical cases limited between 250 to 350 words (in Microsoft Word format, Times New Roman, Font size-12, 1.5 line space). The abstract should have title (in CAPITAL case), name of the authors (First name followed by Surname in full), affiliation and e-mail address of presenting author (italicized). The abstract should include Background, Aim/Objectives, Materials and Methods, Results and Conclusions (With all sub headings bold) followed by 4-6 Keywords. The name of presenting author should be bold and underlined and the session and technical mode of presentation (oral/poster) should be clearly specified on the right upper corner of page. The final mode of presentation shall be decided by the organizing committee depending on the quality and number of abstracts received for each session. The abstracts will be screened and presenting author shall be intimated for the acceptance of abstract and mode of presentation via email. Only accepted abstracts shall be allowed to present in the Convention; any abstract submitted during the course of Convention shall not be considered for presentation. The presenting author should be registered for the Convention and the number of abstracts per presenting author is limited to two. At least one of the contributing authors should be registered for the Convention for publication of abstracts in the compendium.

Each presenting author shall be given time of 5 minutes for presentation. The author shall upload their PPTs well in advance at the presentation venue during the conference.

Guidelines for Poster presentation

The Poster should be prepared on cloth or paper (Non-degradable material of any kind would not be allowed) of size of 48 inch (vertical) × 36 inch (horizontal) including borders. The author shall display their posters well in advance at the presentation venue during the conference.
