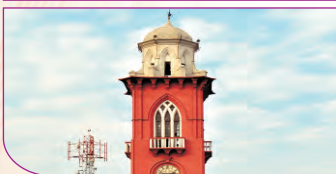
About IAWV

Accommodation, Weather and Transportation

Delegates may be accommodated in the GADVASU Guest House located within the University campus, subject to availability and on first-come, first-serve basis. The allotment will be made at the time of registration as per University rules and applicable tariff. In addition, a range of hotels of various categories are available in Ludhiana city and in the vicinity of the campus, offering accommodation options with tariffs approximately between Rs. 1000 and Rs. 8000 per day. Delegates opting for hotel accommodation are required to make their own arrangements in advance after prior intimation and completion of payment formalities.

Ludhiana experiences pleasant winter weather in December, with daytime temperatures ranging between 20°C and 23°C and cooler mornings and evenings between 8°C and 11°C, making it comfortable for travel and academic activities. Delegates are advised to carry light woollen clothing for early mornings and late evenings.

Ludhiana is well connected by air, rail and road. Regular bus, taxi and cab services are also available from nearby cities and local transport such as auto-rickshaws and app-based cabs provide easy access to the University campus.

Submission of Abstracts

Participants are invited to submit original research abstracts related to any of the above mentioned conference themes. The abstract must not exceed 250 words and should be prepared in MS Word Format using Times New Roman font, size 12 (with 1.5 line spacing where applicable). Authors must clearly mention the serial number of the theme under which the abstract is being submitted.

Only one abstract per theme per presenting author will be accepted. Selected abstracts will be invited for presentation during the scientific sessions and awards will be given for the best oral and poster presentations in each session.

Abstract after due date shall not be included in the compendium. It is mandatory for the presenting author to register for the conference. Participation in the conference is open for only women scientists, teachers, researchers, students, field veterinarians and corporate personals.
